President's Report - (Karen Tepoorten)

- Chipotle restaurant night \$132.00
- RaiseRight/ShopwithScrip Amie continues to coordinate. An amount of \$3,096.70 was raised and a check cut to Christi to distribute to individual athletes as outlined. An amount of \$187.98 will be rolled over to next year, as these proceeds were earned by athletes who either left the gym or graduated.
- Peaches fundraiser-The booster club raised \$2,866 through peach sales. Peaches have been delivered, and jarred salsas will be here this week.

She will be speaking about the benefits of taking an active part during the parents' meeting at the beginning of Fall. She will coordinate with Christi the date and time for the parents' meeting. It was suggested that those not wanting to participate in booster club may want to make a flat donation if they would like.
- August 20 restaurant night at Modern Market in HR, was cancelled due to being a busy time of year with school starting. It was suggested that dinner nights would be better attended on a Friday evening if possible, taking into consideration both of the boys' and girls' practice schedules.
- Discussion whether the score book/yearbook should be modified to include pictures throughout the season and more of a picture book. We are also looking for a low cost printer option. To be discussed further.
- Kimberly suggested a fundraiser of Village Inn pies to happen around Thanksgiving. She is looking into the feasibility.
- Holiday wreaths will be another fundraiser this year, planned delivery December 1st. Please look for future details soon.
- Shop X is planned for September 10th this year. Mark your calendars for our biggest fundraiser! Everyone should plan on attending and practices will be modified to allow for the biggest turnout.
 - o Last year IGBC made \$14,700, sold 159 tickets with 151 check-ins
 - Have to reach minimum of 125 tickets sold & check-ins to meet criteria
 - o This year, every ticket will need a specific name attached to it
 - The goal is to sell 5 tickets at \$30 per athlete
 - o In 'n Out will be catering lunch for the event this year. YUM!
